Richardson Terrace pump station - update

July 2018

We're continuing work constructing a pump station in Richardson Terrace, to reduce flood risk in the Bells Creek area and improve the quality of water discharging into the Heathcote River.

The works to construct a new stormwater pump station and stormwater treatment device at 12 Richardson Terrace are progressing well, with the underground structures complete and the outfall pipes to the river laid. We have begun the next stage installing the equipment and completing the above ground works. Due to the discovery of contaminated material in the outfall excavations, works were delayed as the material was removed and any remaining material capped to prevent the contaminants spreading. As a result the main above ground works won't be completed until the end of August 2018, later than previously hoped. The current road closure on Richardson Terrace will remain in place until these works are completed.
