Marriner Street-west and Wakefield Avenue Enhancements

Thank you for responding to the consultation and providing comment regarding the above project.

Since writing to all the submitters on the Marriner St-west project, the plan included the provision of two mobility parking spaces on Marriner Street. It has now been brought to our attention that these spaces do not provide sufficient protection for people with disabilities, and that we should have been using the guidance contained in *AS/NZS 2890 (Set):2009*, which requires a wider space for mobility parking. The design has been updated to reflect this guidance and now proposes installing 3.2 metre wide mobility parking spaces on the side roads. There continues to be two spaces provided, one on Marriner Street (east) and one on Nayland Street (west). The area which was originally proposed to be used as mobility spaces has now been changed to time restricted parking for all vehicles. The amended plan shows the revised layout as outlined above.
