Thank you for your email, received on 1 July 2016. You requested the following information, under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA):

"the total owed in outstanding rates as of 30 June 2016 and the total number of ratepayers in arrears. Could I also have the largest rates bill due and the smallest bill due."

Release of information

As at 30 June 2016, net rates arrears totalled \$11.51 million - this figure includes Canterbury Regional Council rates, and comprises both residential and commercial rates.

This figure includes 15,329 rates accounts in credit totalling \$5.08 million and 16,708 rates accounts in arrears totalling \$16.59 million.

The smallest amount of arrears was 1 cent and the largest was \$265,000.
