
Ferry Road - stormwater renewal works

Why The brick barrel stormwater drain running beneath Ferry Road has been identified as having damage, threatening the structural integrity and water tightness of the drain.
Where 398B Ferry Road extending to 456 Ferry Rd, Woolston
When Monday, 19 February to Friday, 22 March 2024. Monday to Saturday, 7am to 6pm (weather/site condition dependent).

Details

- Our contractor, Seipp Construction, will be installing new manholes to accommodate future lining works to renew sections of the brick barrel drain running beneath Ferry Road.
- The manhole works are necessary to provide access to install the new lining. Lining works are due to take place in October 2024.
- While manhole works are underway, traffic management will be in place. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained on Ferry Road with speed restrictions and cyclists merging. Property access will be maintained for most properties. However, directly outside the works will be affected with restricted vehicle access.
- Safety is our number one priority and it's your responsibility, too. Stay clear and stay alert. Please keep children and pets at a safe distance from the worksite.
