DECISION OF THE CHRISTCHURCH DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

- [1] This is an application by **TEAH RAMSAY CHAPMAN** ('the Applicant') for a Manager's Certificate pursuant to section 219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 ('the Act'). The application was received on 25 October 2023 and related to the applicant's employment at Queenspark Alehouse, Christchurch.
- [2] The Police did not oppose the application.
- [3] The Inspector, Paul Tweed, recommended the application be determined by way of public hearing on the basis the Applicant has failed to show the knowledge required by section 222 of the Act by failing to attend an interview with the Licensing Inspector.
- [4] In response to a telephone call, Ms Chapman advised that she wished to with draw her current application and would send the Inspectorate written confirmation of that decision.

- [5] The matter was duly set down for a hearing on 6 August 2024 at 11:30am at the Civic Offices of the Christchurch City Council. The Applicant failed to attend this hearing. As at the time of the hearing, written confirmation of her withdrawal had not been received.
- [6] The application is declined on the grounds of the Applicant failing to attend appointments with the Licensing Inspector and failing to attend the hearing and failing to provide written notice of withdrawal of her application by the date of the hearing.
