We have signage up saying we can call them a taxi or direct them to the taxi stand downstairs.

c. What other steps does the applicant propose to take aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol?

We get very few customers we need to worry about, but when we do, we offer them water and food. At the end of the night we check they have a way to get home safely.

d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

As we're a small bar, I pretty much only ever put duty managers on. I also only like to hire experienced DMs too, so we rarely have the risk of somebody new on. On the rare occasion somebody new is working, we start by giving them a rundown of the liquor rules and penalties.

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

We have chilled water in caraffes on the bar easily accessible.

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Noise mitigation plan attached. As a theatre, we make relatively low noise and our patrons are relatively well behaved.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

We have had very little issue so far. Once a customer wrote in the bathrooms with chalk about how she loved the performer that night. We also have monthly meetings with the other terrace customers, and piggy back off their security systems etc, so we feel we have an army of help around us should anything become an issue.

i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

The other bars on the Terrace, Hereford St etc. I think we are a positive alternative to fast drinking in the area – people can come and will sit on one drink for the hour that the show is going. Our audiences are generally there to watch a show too, not to get wasted.

We're on the Terrace :-)
