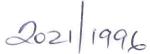

The restourant toes not engage in any inhouse promotion of alcohol or happy hour. Alcohol is served responsibly and in moderation. The restourant focuses on Promoting the food menu

All Staff are trained with the Skill and knowledge of identifying the requirements within the Act. Staff are also given support and Skills required to their Job under the supervision of the manager.

The current noise level of the premise is very low. The premise is enclosed of our times (only two entrance) as doors are on a push pull basis.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them? The Premise is under 24 HR video surveilance, this can be an effective solution for preventing vandalism. Responsibility is promoted in the host responsibility Policy. Customers and diners are reminded to not create nuisance and on and around the premise.

L. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

Bottle-O (liquer store), The sideline sports bar. There will not be any contribution or increase in account newted problems in the cine as our primary focus is on food. (ustomers are focused on food and alcohol is only served if the customer can legally engage in its consumption.

the premise is situated in 'richmond village' with other premises being used for commercial purpose; such as takeaways, Laundry, Liquor store, dairy and specialty grocenies. Granting of licence will have no impact on neighbouring land use as the primary puppos of the restautant is food.

 - There is a small administration charge for our assistance in loading the content onto the licensing notification webpage. The fee will need to be paid in advance of publication.
 - · Your notice will be published within a week of your application being received and the public notice fee being paid.
- 2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 15 working days.
- 3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application in form 7 is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).
