Alcohol is never encouraged, offered at reduced prices, or promoted in an irresponsible way. Staff members have access to a copy of the Intoxication Assessment Tool. The existing license restricts the applicant from selling individual servings of

d) What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

The current licence prohibits the applicant from selling singles of products for less than \$6.00 (condition (a(i)). Alcohol is never encouraged, offered at reduced prices, or promoted in an irresponsible way. Staff members have access to a copy of the Intoxication Assessment Tool.

e) To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations).

Drinking water is freely available during any tastings.

f) What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

To ensure that staff carry out their responsibilities effectively and understand their legal obligations, they undergo regular training provided through The Bottle-O franchise. The applicant also has a set of question and answers (Staff training manual for alcohol sales) which the staff are required to read and confirm their understanding of the content.

The premises have CCTV cameras to monitor customers and enhance security. The premises is well-lit both inside and outside and maintained in a tidy manner. The lighting inside the premises is adequate for staff to check IDs and keep an eye on customers.

g) What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Given the premises operates as a retail activity, concerns regarding noise are unlikely to arise. The applicant is not aware of any noise related concerns arising from the premises under its management.

h) What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

The applicant is not aware of any incidents related to nuisance and vandalism concerning the premises. There is sufficient lighting inside and outside to deter loiterers. There is CCTV for monitoring and security purposes. The premises is within a commercial complex on Stanmore Road among other businesses/retailers/food and beverage outlets.

Customers are encouraged to raise any concerns with a duty manager and/or director regarding noise, nuisance, and vandalism.

 i) What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

The Sideline Sports Bar is about 70m from the premises.

New World Stanmore is about 290m south of the premises.

Super Liquor Edgeware is about 2.2km northwest of the premises.

Thirsty Liquor Victoria Street is about 2.9km southwest of the premises.

The premises is an existing premises and has been operating in this locality for some time without any issues or concerns. The applicant has sufficient systems in place to ensure that sale and supply of alcohol is undertaken safely and responsibly.

j) What is the land near the proposed premises being used for? Will the granting of a licence for your premises impact on changing neighbouring land use? If so, in what way?

The land near the premises is being used mainly for commercial/retail purposes. The premises is located within a suburban shopping centre. There are various food and beverage outlets in the same complex as the premises. The granting of the renewal of the licence is unlikely to impact on neighbouring land use given the premises holds a licence of the same kind as applied by the applicant.
