Signs will be visible to all guests and staff with information that if they need us to book a taxi for them we can. There will be a phone available for staff to call or we can help the guest use the Uber app to book.

c. What other steps does the applicant propose to take aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol?

Signs stating it is a condition of our licence that food, low and non alcohol drinks and free drinking water are available at all times.

Signs advising free water available to all guests in the bar area, dining and outdoor area. Signs advising intoxicated people will not be served. Signs advising minors will not be served alcohol.

d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

Clear signage. All staff will be trained and understand the Act in relation to the sale or alcohol to prohibited persons. Duty Managers on every shift. Weekly staff trainings and quiz's.

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations and locations)

All guest tables will be laid out with glasses and water jugs. Front of house staff will be trained to always ensure every guest has water jugs topped up when running low - this will be part of our front of house service and training. Water stations readily available with fresh water and glasses (one on the bar, one in the main dining area and one setup in outdoor area).

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

2 weeks training before we open to the public and then weekly training sessions on compliance with the law.

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

To help with the compliance with noise levels, we will close any outdoor areas after 10.30pm and any open windows. If we do hold a one-off event (for example staying open later for New Year's Eve), communicating with any residential neighbours in advance.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

We have new security cameras installed that covers the whole outside of the building, staff will be trained on how to deal with any issues should they arise.



i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

There are 2 other restaurants in the vicinity, granting the licence will not contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in Sumner.

  - There is a small administration charge for our assistance in loading the content onto the licensing notification webpage. The fee will need to be paid in advance of publication.
  - · Your notice will be published within a week of your application being received and the public notice fee being paid.
- 2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 25 working days.
- 3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).

You will be issued an invoice at your lodgement meeting when you file your application. Payment of Fees MUST be made immediately on receiving the invoice.

The information will be provided to the statutory reporting agencies (the Police, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Council's Licensing Inspectors) for the purposes of assessing and reporting on your application, and to the Christchurch District Licensing Committee for the purposes of making a decision on your application. This information may form part of a public hearing of your application before the Christchurch District Licensing Committee and may be used in the Committee's decision for your application. Decisions will be made publicly available.

The Council is required to keep a record of every premises licence application (including for renewals and variations) filed with the District Licensing Committee and the Committee's decision on it. This information (which includes the application and all attachments) is made available to the Council's Licensing Inspectors, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Police for the purposes of monitoring ongoing compliance with any licence conditions and undertakings, Duty Manager appointments, and the Act.

#### 14. Processing Timelines:

On average about 5-6 weeks is required for a standard application to allow for processing, statutory reporting on your application, and issuing of a District Licensing Committee (DLC) decision on your licence. Timelines will be longer if there are agency oppositions or missing information on your application.
