We have a sign offering to book taxis on behalf of guests.

We have very limited visibility of alcohol in the store. We have a LOT of signs up about expectations of age and behaviour etc. We have water freely available at a water cooler.

d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

All staff (not just Duty Managers) are regularly reminded of their obligations in both training sessions and posts in our rostering application.

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

Water cooler right by the front door with glasses and jugs - free for all to use. Plumbed in. We will also serve them water if they ask.

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

All staff (not just Duty Managers) are regularly reminded of their obligations in both training sessions and posts in our rostering application. Our staff have access to an intranet portal which has all our policies documented for them to view at any time.

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Very little noise issues - quiet restaurant with no late nights, bands or noisy patrons etc.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

There are no particular issues here that could be directly attributed to the Diner.

i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

Casino, multiple restaurants (Mexicanos, Dirty Land, Boo Radleys etc). None that I believe cause issues in the area.

Land next door is a car park. We have no direct neighbours adjoining the property.

All alcohol licence application public notices are published on the dedicated webpage located on ccc.govt.nz/alcohol. Applications are no longer required to be published in the local newspaper.

- 1. We will take care of the publication of your public notice when you make your application to us.
 - There is a small administration charge for our assistance in loading the content onto the licensing notification webpage. The fee will need to be paid in advance of publication.
 - Your notice will be published within a week of your application being received and the public notice fee being paid.
- 2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 15 working days.
- 3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application in form 7 is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).

15. Processing Timelines:				
Manager Certificate applications should be made well before your certificate is required. On average about 5-6 weeks is required for a standard application to allow for processing, statutory reporting on your application, and issuing of a District Licensing Committee (DLC) decision on your licence.
