staff will be trained in how to distinguish intoxicated people and what the next steps are to handle these people and records of staff training will be kept.

very minimal at this moment, if we do encounter high levels of noise we will stop serving alcohol and provide them safe transport home.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

We will be calling 111 immediately and we also have CCTV in place to record any nuisance and vandalism

i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

We have a Chinese restaurant, butchery, Japanese restaurant, all the surrounded restaurants sell alcohol responsibly and had no problems so far

We are inside the west plaza mall and surrounding the mall are other small grocery shops, tea shops, restaurant which most sell alcohol and obtaining on license on our site would not further change neighboring land use
