We provide a free phone to use for taxis and information on the different taxi companies. There is a taxi rank outside the front door.

c. What other steps does the applicant propose to take aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol?

We use current HANZ signage for intox, no ID - no service, no supply to minors. We train and upskill our staff on the above and maintain high standards

d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

Our staff are comprehensively trained to cover these areas. We hold regular and ongoing training to ensure all policies are adhered to, ie asking for ID if customer looks under 25, watching for signs of influence & intoxication, etc

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

Water is available in all areas, a water station is situated by the bar with signage

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

We hold regular and ongoing training sessions with staff to ensure we are following the requirements of the Acr. We have step by step systems when asking for ID and how to identify intoxication (SCAB method) on staff notice board and tills.

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

We use an internal music system for background music and only have live music on a Sunday from 4-7pm. Management monitor and control noise levels and do not believe it affects the local area.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

There are currently no levels of nuisance or vandalism on the premise. We monitor and react to any future or potential issues that may occur.

i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

Aikmans Bar, Brewers Arms Bar & Sprig & Fern - these are all established bars and we do not believe there will be any increase in alcohol related problems.
