Our staff operate a system for identification of intoxication and all staff are trained on our in house host responsibility policy.

d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

All staff are trained to ask for identification, and will refuse service if in doubt as to age or intoxication. All staff undergo regular training on the Sale of Alcohol Act and their obligations.

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

Water will be freely available during any in-house tasting events

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

Staff will undergo training as part of the induction process before commencing work in regards to their responsibilities under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. This will be supplemented by regular refresher training sessions, as well as on-the-job training.

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Noise levels will be monitored by the Duty Manager. Customers will be reminded to keep noise levels appropriate when leaving the store.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Our management monitor the premises and the surrounding areas for vandalism, nuisance etc. and aim to prevent disorderly behavior before it occurs/escalates. CCTV will monitor the exteriors of the premises to act as a deterrent.

 What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

There are no licensed premises in the immediate vicinity. We take our obligations under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 very seriously and, as such, are extremely diligent and forthright in dealing with any compliance issues, so as to ensure the sale, supply, and consumption of alc

The premises are set back from the road within a large carpark. The area surrounding the carpark is residential. The granting of a licence will not impact on neighbouring land use.
