CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL RMA/2019/2020 PROPOSED NEW MIXED USE DEVELOPMENT AT COLLETT'S CORNER MINUTE 4 OF COMMISSIONER

Introduction

- 1. The hearing for this proposal was held yesterday, with appearances made by the applicant, submitters in support, submitters in opposition and the Council.
- 2. Before I adjourned proceedings, I verbally requested some further assistance from the Council and the applicant.
- 3. The purpose of this minute is to briefly record the nature of that request for the formal hearing record and for all parties' information.

Advice on draft conditions

- 4. At the outset of the hearing, I made clear to all parties that one of the lines of inquiry I would be following with various presenters was in relation to conditions of consent. I also noted that my doing so should not be an indication that I have made a decision about the proposal. Rather, the hearing afforded my only opportunity to ensure the conditions are fit-for-purpose should my decision ultimately be to grant consent.
- 5. The key issues for the conditions identified over the course of the day included:
 - a. general discussion about the extent to which conditions could be made more certain and provide for objective measures and/or processes to achieve desired effects-management outcomes;
 - b. the need to update 'Condition 1' to refer to the final development plans;
 - c. the purpose, detail and process for certifying a lighting plan;
 - d. the wording of draft conditions relating to vehicle parking facilities and associated internal signage;
 - e. the drafting of the proposed conditions relating to acoustic insulation and certification;
 - f. detail about the manner in which security gates would be operated;
 - g. the potential need for conditions relating to the brick barrel drain running beneath the site; and
 - h. the potential need for a detailed design certification process.

- 6. I asked the representatives for the Council and the applicant to confer with a view of agreeing a final set of conditions to be attached to the applicant's final written reply. If there are any conditions not agreed upon, I expect the parties will make clear (in writing) the reasons for not reaching agreement and for preferring their respective drafting solution.
- 7. That information is to be provided by 5pm on Wednesday 11 March 2020.
- 8. After receiving that information, I will then consider whether I have all necessary information before me to make a decision on the proposal.
- 9. Provided that is the case, I will then advise all parties of the formal closing of the hearing and issue my decision within 15 working days.

Next Steps

- 10. As detailed above, the applicant and the Council are to confer on draft conditions and submit a final set with the applicant's written reply no later than 5pm on 11 March 2020.
