The riders are of all ages and abilities. In our consultation with young people who are regular users of this skate park, they have asked for: More ramps, rails, a halfpipe and a pump track. They have all pointed to the Knight Stream skate park as the design that they would want to copy. The other very consistent feedback from both young people and families in this area is that the playground is no longer fit for purpose and badly needs renewal. A playground renewal alongside the skatepark would lead to more families using the park and both a more enjoyable experience as well as a safer environment. This community is shown in the NZ deprivation index to have a high level of need, and a playground renewal in the heart of the Hei Hei community is crucial to follow the skatepark renovation.
