We had around 35 people who shared over 245 ideas and comments about the area. We've noticed a few popular themes:

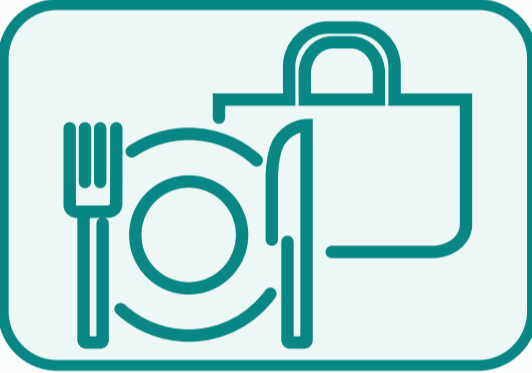


## Community services

Community garden spaces to time share, grow veges, herbs... for all ages to grow and learn.  
Micro-parks. Green spaces, places for children to play.



## Commercial and hospitality

Shopping districts like Little High, Boxed Quarter and Cashel Mall are helpful concentrations of businesses.  
Discussions between hospitality and residents.

## Residential needs and housing options

Need more diverse living spaces, affordable for all ages, ensure good outside areas and parklets.  
More social housing but with community development and wrap-around services.



## Movement

Safer bicycle lock ups.  
Make the city centred around walking/cycling and improve buses so they're frequent.
