Nomination guide

Each year our city benefits from the service of volunteers and others who go above and beyond the call of duty for Christchurch, its people and its environment.

We recognise these valued contributions with our annual Civic Awards.

Is there a person, group, or business you would like to nominate? Nominations are open now for the 2021 Civic Awards.

Who can be nominated?

Anyone, and any organisation or business, which does significant work, usually of a voluntary nature, to benefit Christchurch. A nominee can be any age and does not have to be living in Christchurch.

Who can make a nomination?

Anyone who lives in Christchurch can make a nomination. If you want to nominate someone you will need two other people to support your nomination and you will all need to sign a form.

If an association, club, society or business is making a nomination you'll need to include the names, job titles and signatures of three executive members. If possible, the nomination should be endorsed by the organisation at a formal meeting and recorded in the minutes.

How do I make a nomination?

See our online form at ccc.govt.nz (Search: Civic Awards). The form is downloadable and printable. It can be completed online **but you will need to print it for you and other nominators to sign**. The form is also available from any of our service centres or libraries.

Please provide all the information requested in the form. We will not consider your nomination if your form is not complete.

Your nomination needs to be with us by **5pm on Tuesday 31 August 2021**.

What information do I need to provide?

Full contact details will be needed for you and the other nominators, and for the nominee. You will also be asked for other information that will help the selection committee make a decision.

Do I need permission from the nominee?

No. Anyone nominated for an award will have the opportunity to accept or decline the award. They will also be told that you nominated them.

What if the person I want to nominate has died?

If a person has died within 12 months of the closing date for nominations they may still be nominated.

Are there awards for work that benefits only part of the city?

Yes. These are Community Service Awards. Please contact one of our service centres or a member of the relevant community board for more information.

How are nominations judged?

A Committee of Christchurch City Council elected members considers the nominations and presents a shortlist for the full Council to approve.

How will I know if my nomination is successful?

We will let you know. If your nominee has agreed to accept an award, someone will call you to discuss the nomination. A list of award winners will be published on Newsline at ccc.govt.nz/newsline and in newspapers.

What can I do if my nomination is not successful?

You are welcome to make a fresh nomination next year, if you have new information to include.

When are the awards presented?

Civic Awards are presented by the Mayor on behalf of the Council at a ceremony in the Town Hall towards the end of the year.

What if my nominee has already received an award?

If the nominee already has a Civic Award they cannot receive another, even if it is for something different.
