

Free Design Out Crime Advisory Service

Crime Prevention through Environmental Design advice







What is the Design Out Crime Advisory Service?

The Design Out Crime Advisory Service's purpose is to ensure that Christchurch has access to the best crime prevention design advice available. Our goal is to improve safety and reduce crime in Christchurch. It is co-funded by Christchurch City Council and the Crime Prevention Unit of the Ministry of Justice.

Who can benefit from this service?

Developers, property owners, planners, architects, urban designers, landscape architects and designers, other design professionals, project managers and community groups. All developments can benefit from crime prevention design advice and any development (new build or rebuild) that has publically accessible space in it or around it is eligible for the service.

What can we do for you?

We can give you advice, ideas and recommendations on how to make your development safer from crime, while saving money and enhancing amenity values and usability. We aim to add value to your project, without delaying it, while reducing ongoing costs of operating and managing the completed development.

How will we do this?

Our Advisors are expert in crime prevention strategies, including Crime Prevention through Environmental Design (CPTED, pronounced "sep-ted"). We have proven methods of reducing opportunities for crime to occur in and around your property, while increasing its appeal to the people you want to attract. We will help make your property safer and feel safer for your customers and the public.

Why is CPTED important?

Safety from crime is an important part of successful, vibrant places. CPTED is recognised as a powerful, practical tool to achieve this. Many of the plans and strategies that direct the rebuild of Christchurch (including the Christchurch Central



Recovery Plan, the Greater Christchurch Recovery Strategy, the Christchurch Transport Plan), include reference to CPTED. Developments requiring Resource Consents in the Central City Business Zone are required to consider CPTED.

What can CPTED assist with?

- General safety principles including natural supervision, access control, protection of private space, and quality surroundings.
- The qualities of safer places, including safe movement and connections, being able to see and be seen, layout, activity mix, ownership, and maintenance and management.
- Context and proximity to activity generators or crime hotspots.
- Positive and negative safety impacts on surroundings.
- Night time context, including mitigating unlawful and unwanted uses and activities.
- Anti graffiti strategies.
- Design of pedestrian access and internal public areas.
- Design of publicly accessible toilet facilities.
- Design and placement of lighting, plantings, car parking, service lanes and entrances.
- Storage spaces for incoming goods, rubbish, cycles, equipment.
- Definition of private, semi-public and public spaces.

When is it best to include CPTED?

CPTED provides the greatest value for the least cost when applied "little and often" from the early stages of design.

We can assist from concept through to post-completion, with "big picture" issues through to small, site specific details.
