Sustainable Events Canterbury: Exhibitor guide and approved packaging list

As an exhibitor, your participation is key to advancing sustainable practices at events in our city. By joining us, you'll boost your brand's reputation, support local sustainability efforts, and stand out in the industry.

You'll also have the chance to engage with attendees about the importance of sustainable waste management. Thank you for helping us create more sustainable events.

The project

The Sustainable Events Canterbury (SEC) initiative brings together the efforts of the Christchurch City Council's Composting Food Packaging at Events (CFPE) initiative and the Selwyn District Council Selwyn Events Sustainably Initiative (SESI).

This consolidation aims to simplify things for event organisers and exhibitors within the wider Christchurch region so that regardless of whether the event is in Lincoln or Linwood the packaging requirements will be the same.

SEC helps event organizers in Christchurch minimize waste and maximize landfill diversion through the use of approved compostable packaging and effective waste sorting practices.

Participating events operate a closed-loop system where all food is served in approved compostable packaging. This means that both food scraps and packaging can go into designated green bins for local composting.

It's important to note that while numerous products claim to be compostable, there are no New Zealand standards to prevent false claims, so this initiative only endorses packaging that has been vetted by the Council and local compost facilities to guarantee compatibility with our composting processes and standards.

Each event provides three waste streams for public use, similar to home kerbside bins but with event-specific distinctions:

- **Green**: For organics, including food and approved compostable packaging (unlike regular green bins that exclude packaging).
- **Yellow**: For clean cardboard, plastic bottles, drink cans, and glass bottles (mirroring standard recycling practices).
- **Red**: For landfill waste including all lids.

Some events, depending on budget, deploy bin ambassadors at stations to educate attendees on proper waste disposal practices.

All waste generated at events undergoes rigorous hand-sorting by trained staff or volunteers. This meticulous process is essential to eliminate contamination in compost and recycling streams, thereby optimizing landfill diversion.

Despite providing dedicated bins, events often experience high contamination rates, necessitating this sorting process for materials to be accepted at local processing facilities.

Through these measures, Sustainable Events Canterbury not only enhances environmental stewardship at events but also sets a precedent for sustainable event management practices across Christchurch.



Guidelines for exhibitors

For all events participating you must only use approved compostable food packaging listed in this guide.

- Napkins: You can use any serviettes and napkins providing they do not have coloured inks.
- **Cutlery**: You can use any wooden and bamboo cutlery and chopsticks. Any cutlery made from other materials require pre-approval.
- **Bags**: You can use any paper bags providing they are not coloured (no inks), are not waxed and are not water resistant/lined.
- **Straws**: You can only use only cardboard or paper straws providing they do not have coloured inks (no bioplastic/PLA/plastic).
- **Custom designs**: You can have custom designs printed on packaging using black ink only coloured inks on food packaging are not permitted.
- **Lined materials**: PLA, bioplastics or aqueous lined products are limited on a case-by-case basis. These may be accepted for use at the event but may go to landfill. Please discuss with us before purchasing.
- **Cups**: PLA, aqueous and bioplastic linings are allowed but may go to landfill. PET lined cups are not permitted unless stated otherwise.
- **Plastic**: Ballons, glow sticks, glitter, any plastic-wrapped and single-use plastic items will not be permitted. Some commercially packaged items may be allowed but this must be checked with the event organiser first.
- **Distributors**: You can buy these products from many selected distributers in the city but please ensure they are the correct approved products by checking the reference codes shown in this guide.
- Audit: Please ensure you bring product boxes and your receipt with you onsite for auditing. You must be able
 to show the auditor the packaging brand and reference codes to demonstrate it is the approved brand and
 material.
- **Cease trade**: Please note you may be required to cease trading at the request of Event staff if you fail to use approved compostable food packaging products. A complete list of approved food packaging products is included in this guide.

Exhibitor terms and conditions

As a condition to operating at an event taking part in this project, you agree to comply with the conditions of the project which is being run by the Christchurch City Council.

- (a) Read this document carefully, taking note of the complete list of approved food packaging products.
- (b) Retain a copy for your own reference.

1. Exhibitor requirements

1.1. You must read and understand the information outlined in this document.

2. Approved products and suppliers

2.1. For all Events taking part in the project, you must only purchase and use approved compostable food packaging included in this document.

3. Audits

3.1. You must cooperate with Event staff carrying out on-site compostable food packaging audits ("Audit").

4. Failure to comply with the requirements

4.1. You may be required to cease trading at the request of Event staff if you fail to meet any of the requirements outlined in this guide.

Thank you for your cooperation and support in diverting more event waste away from landfill.
