Guiding Principles

Members of the Red Zones Transformative Group represent the interests of residents by:

- Appreciating the significance of this land, and being genuinely interested in outcomes and initiatives to help realise its potential.
- Upholding the vision and objectives of the Ōtākaro River Corridor (as defined in the Regeneration Plan).
- Contributing their knowledge and perspective, but not promoting the views or positions of any particular interest and stakeholder group.
- Using best endeavours to make decisions that take into account the interests of all parts of the community, and residents of Christchurch.
- Working in a collaborative and co-operative way, with other group members, with agencies and with communities.
- Having a broad understanding of current and future land uses and various agreements already in place.
- Land Information New Zealand and Christchurch City Council acknowledge that they have a special relationship with respect to infrastructure works and maintenance within the Christchurch Red Zones. The Group will not be tasked with approvals for such works and maintenance.
