5. Acceptance of Conditions of Service

- 5.1 If the collection contractor is unable to drive down the lane due to obstructions, or if collection is restricted (by trees, shrubs, gradient, width, parked cars, etc); the contractor will leave the wheelie bins uncollected and apply stickers to the bins explaining why they were not collected.
- 5.2 If the contactor is unable to collect on more than two consecutive occasions due to obstructions then the service may be cancelled.
- 5.3 The property owners/managers indemnify Council against claims for damage to the lane surface, foundation, services or any other thing within the lane boundaries caused or accelerated by the action of the collection truck in traversing the lane to collect the wheelie bins.

Accidental damage to fences, letter boxes or other items on individual properties, which can be verified as being caused by the contractor will be subject to normal claims procedures through the Contractors Public Liability Insurance.

- 5.4 The Council will not be liable for any unlawful activity that may occur as a consequence of providing the requested service.
- 5.5 If any health and safety matter is reported and no action is taken to eliminate the hazard, the contactor has the right to cancel the service.
