Worsleys Spur drainage works starting

We are shortly starting work to improve the stormwater network in your neighbourhood.

March Construction, working for the Council, will start work next week installing drainage in a section of Worsleys Road (shown in green below). A new stormwater pipe will be installed in the road and this will eventually link to a larger pipe which will be constructed in Spring to channel the water down into Worsleys Valley.

Starting next week, March Construction will set up on site to construct the drain on the east side of the road. This work is expected to take around 11 weeks.

The hillside work constructing the downhill pipe cannot be done in winter months due to ground conditions, so this work will start in spring. The drain will be made operational once the pipe is completed.

Footpath and channel work will be done at a later date, when funding is available.

We expect the road to be kept open for the duration of the works, but it will be one-way at times. Please be on the lookout for changes in traffic management and follow the signage on site.

The team from March Construction will work directly with you if there are any changes to access to your property.
