Wainui Wastewater Reticulation and Treatment Scheme - options

Thank you for making a submission to the Wainui Wastewater Reticulation and Treatment Scheme consultation. All responses have now been analysed for a report to be considered by the Infrastructure, Transport and Environment Committee at its meeting on 4 June 2015. The Committee will make its recommendation which will go to Council in late June for its decision. The staff recommendation is:

• It is recommended that the Committee receive this report and that the Committee recommend to Council that a decision on when to implement Stage 2 of the Wainui Wastewater Scheme be made by the full Council following verbal submissions to the Council as part of the Long Term Plan process.

Summary of feedback

During the consultation period 88 submissions were received. Of these 0 respondents ranked option 1 – property owners cost-sharing arrangements with the Council as their most preferred option (ranked 1), 20 respondents (23%) rated option 2 – deferring the delivery of the Scheme for inclusion in the 2018/2028 LTP as their most preferred option (ranked 1) and 66 respondents ranked option 3 – proceeding as planned (financial year beginning 1 July 2015) as their most preferred option (ranked 1).

Decision making process

A report seeking a recommendation to Council from the Infrastructure, Transport and Environment (ITE) Committee, will be presented to the Committee at its meeting on 4 June 2015, with the meeting starting at 8.30 am. The meeting is a public forum and anyone is welcome to attend and listen.

We have previously advised that deputations (submitters speaking to their submission) would also be heard at this meeting, as well as via the Council LTP (Long Term Plan) process. However the decision has been made to consider all requests to speak through the LTP hearings - this will ensure that Council decision makers will have heard all submitters speak via one process prior to any decision being made.
