NOTICE OF REMOVAL OF MINIMUM PARKING REQUIREMENTS FROM THE DISTRICT PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 55 OF THE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991

We have amended the Christchurch District Plan on 18 February 2022 in accordance with Policy 11 and clause 3.38 of the National Policy Statement on Urban Development 2020 (NPS-UD), to remove all or parts of relevant objectives, policies, rules, and assessment criteria that have the effect of requiring a minimum number of car parks to be provided for any development, land use, or activity.

The accessible parking requirements, parking design standards and minimum loading space requirements in the District Plan are not impacted by the NPS-UD and remain applicable to development proposals.

As required by the Resource Management Act 1991, notice is given in accordance with Section 55(2A)(b). These changes to the District Plan have been made without using the process for plan changes prescribed in Schedule 1. The changes have immediate effect.
