### **SUMMARY OF DECISIONS SOUGHT**

#### **INTRODUCTION**

The period for making submissions to Proposed Plan Change 7 to the Christchurch District Plan closed on 28 June 2021. The notification of this summary of decisions sought is the start of the second stage of the submission process where affected parties have the opportunity to make further submissions.

Further submissions give the opportunity to either support or oppose the submissions already received. It is not another opportunity to make fresh submissions on the Plan Change itself, as a further submission can only be in support of or in opposition to a submission already made to the Council (refer to the summary below).
