Recommendation:

Windermere Road does not meet the threshold for scheduling as an RHA. The houses in the street are mixed in age and style and do not share a collective historical narrative. The street possesses two notable educational/care home sites, which represent historic continuity of use. The former Loreto College chapel (Sisters of Mercy, est. 1930) on the site of Te Ara Hou Otautahi may warrant further investigation as a potential built heritage item.




