SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

1. My full name is William Henry Fulton. I am a Director of Team Architects Christchurch and a Director of Team Architects Limited, a consortium of eight

architectural practices across New Zealand.

2. I have provided evidence on behalf of the Christchurch City Council (the Council) in

respect of Daresbury matters arising from submissions on Plan Change 13 to the

Christchurch District Plan (the **District Plan**; **PC13**). I reaffirm that I am complying

with the Environment Court's Code of Conduct for Expert Witnesses in presenting

this summary of my evidence and responding to the submitter's evidence.

3. My evidence relates specifically to the submission from Daresbury Limited

(Submission #874) seeking that:

Daresbury House (heritage item number 185) be deleted from Appendix (a)

9.3.7.2 Schedule of Significant Historic Heritage' (the Schedule); and

The associated Heritage Setting for Daresbury (heritage setting number 602) (b)

be removed from the Schedule.

4. Having performed a site visit and reviewed the relevant documentation available for

Daresbury House and the associated heritage setting, in my opinion, from a heritage

conservation perspective Daresbury House and the adjusted Setting warrant

protection for the following reasons (in summary):

The building, while damaged, is repairable. (a)

(b) The existing building retains highly significant heritage value.

The proposed repair strategy, while altering some of the heritage fabric (c)

(namely the structural elements within the walls) will not substantially lessen

the heritage significance of the repaired building.

5 My opinion has not changed in regard to the Heritage significance of Daresbury

House and its place on the Schedule of Significant Historic Heritage.
