### What We Are Doing

#### Kilmore Street to Worcester Street:

- **Monday 6 March:** Traffic signage on Durham Street informing commuters of upcoming road changes.
- **Wednesday 8 March:** Durham Street will return to two lanes, see map one.
- Some on-street parking will be available.
- When the road is returned to two lanes, we will be continuing with other minor works.
- Worcester Street to Hereford Street: A road cone taper will merge the two lanes of southbound traffic to one lane.

### Traffic Impacts: Hereford and Cashel Streets

#### Hereford Street Intersection:

**Tuesday 7 March:** A crew will start the kerb and channel, traffic signals and ducting in two areas, see map two.

- Eastbound traffic:
  - \* Left turn from Cambridge Terrace to Hereford Street only.
- Westbound traffic:
  - \* Left turn from Hereford Street to Cambridge Terrace.
  - \* Traffic can continue straight on Hereford Street from CBD.
  - \* **No right turn from Cambridge Terrace onto Hereford Street.**
- Cambridge Terrace Access to Christchurch City Council:
  - \* Westbound on Hereford Street from CBD
  - \* Right turn onto Cashel Street to Montreal Street.

#### Cashel Street Intersection:

- Eastbound and westbound traffic reinstated.
