## Night Works

### Coastal Pathway - Moncks Bay

**What** We'll be maintaining a temporary traffic management layout

### What are we doing?

Due to the recent poor weather, night work will continue from Sunday 22 May, between the hours of 6pm and 6am. Taking into consideration the weather forecast for next week, work could continue through to Thursday night. This work will be completed on Main Road, near Shag Rock (shown on the map below in red).

Due to the minimal traffic impacts witnessed this week during the day, we will continue preparing for the sewer renewal by completing the noisy activities and undertaking investigation work (shown on the map below in green). This work will be completed between the hours of 9am and 7pm.

During our working hours, traffic will be reduced to one lane, and controlled by traffic lights. Two-way traffic will be reinstated outside of our working hours.

### Night Works

Our crews need lights to see what they are working on, therefore you may notice extra light coming from the street. There will be noise from trucks, machinery and crew working overnight.

We know that night works are more disruptive, and our team will try to limit this as much as possible.

### Traffic Impacts

During both day and night work, traffic will be reduced to one lane, and controlled by traffic lights. Two-way traffic will be reinstated outside of our working hours.

Our friendly staff will help people get around our site. The speed limit around our work is 30kph so we can keep our workers safe.

*Please note - we are aware of the overlap of working hours but to be clear, only one work site will be operational at a time.*
