


TRAVEL DIRECTIONS TO AGRICULTURAL PARK - PUBLIC ENTRY/EXIT VIA WIGRAM 3, MCMAHON DR, AUGUSTINE DR.



DISABLED PARKING: All disabled taxis are entitled to enter the Show grounds for drop off only (you must have a pre-purchased ticket available for staff to check).

Disabled parking is available from the main public car park off Wigram Road, McMahon Drive and Augustine Drive. It must be noted there is a distance of at least 200 metres of uneven ground, grass and pathway between the car park and asphalt road within the Show. This land is a public park and the Canterbury A&P Association has no rights to lay asphalt down.

Due to limited space, a valid mobility parking pass MUST be displayed to access the disability parking spots. If a pass can't be displayed, there is a drop-off point for Show Visitors with mobility issues at the Curlests 1 Entrance with direct access to asphalt pathways.

Health and Safety Information for the General Public

From the Show Guide (distributed at the gate):

1. Please abide by the safety rules and signage at the Showgrounds. Follow instructions from Marshals and Show Officials.
2. **In the event of an earthquake emergency, please follow ALL instructions given to you by Show staff. Keep clear of buildings and structures. STOP, DROP & HOLD.**
3. Parents please ensure that children do not enter livestock pens or enclosures. Do not poke, hit or irritate animals. Be aware of stock movement when walking through the Livestock Pavilion and obey signs.
4. Please ensure that you and children in your care do not stand behind horses, cows or bulls. They may not see you there.
5. If visiting the Show with small children we suggest you write your cellphone number on their arm. Should they become separated from you, staff can then easily notify you. A Parent Centre and Lost Children Tent is located on MacKenzie Drive next to the Show Office.
6. The roads within the Showgrounds are open for emergency and Show vehicles as well as horses, cattle and other livestock, particularly around the ASB Arena and the ANZ Cattle Lawn. Be aware of vehicular and animal traffic around the Showgrounds particularly if you have children in your care.
7. SHOW INFORMATION OFFICE AND LOST PROPERTY LOCATED AT THE TREASURER'S HUT, VILLAGE GREEN.
8. When using the Bayleys Member's Marquees, please adhere to any signage and instructions from Continental staff. In the event of an emergency, Continental staff will guide you to your exits.
